

In February, we celebrated a major milestone: adding a 4th Sunday service to make room for the growing number of people coming each week! Weekly, people are lining up to come and worship together. As we rejoice in this season of growth, we're also praying expectantly for the completion of our new building soon!

For Sant Jordi, one of Catalunya's most beloved holidays, I was thrilled to be right in the heart of the celebration! At our Ministry Center, we hosted a book booth where neighbors came to connect and celebrate. We handed out roses, custom bookmarks, and Catalan copies of the Gospel of John-- a simple, joyful way to share Jesus' love through local tradition and meaningful conversation.





Over 200 women gathered for a beautiful park event. It was a relaxed space to share food, friendship, and conversations about our walks with God. Many women invited their friends who do not attend church, and beautiful connection was made. I even met a Filipino woman passing by and invited her to church—proof that God moves in unexpected moments!



MY HIGHLIGHTS



I celebrated 10 YEARS of being on staff at ICB this November 2. As I look back, I'm humbled by the joy, the grief, the growth, and the countless moments that have shaped me. This community has been one of God's greatest gifts to my life—a place where I've learned, loved, and seen His faithfulness again and again.

This year, I had the opportunity to be featured on the "Neither Here Nor There" podcast with hosts Laura and Ruthie Gomez, discussing the entering stage of transition. We explored how to navigate change with grace, find community in new seasons, and process disappointment in healthy, faith-filled ways-- topics that deeply resonate with the missionary and cross-cultural journey.





I had the privilege of speaking to 400 missionary colleagues at **Europe Together**, our retreat for all AGWM missionaries across Europe held ever 3 years. I shared on the topic of loss and grief and how God meets us in pain and redeems our stories. It was a sacred time of honesty, healing, and renewed hope in Jesus!

VISION FROM 2025...

Last year, our 2025 vision was to...

- 1. Offer 2 more Kids Camps to neighboring cities through our local campuses.
 - We launched BOTH camps in neighboring cities out of our 2 other campuses! There was an incredible response, and many new families have connected with the church because of it.
- 2. Re-launch men's ministry under strong leadership.
 - A wonderful leader stepped up, raised men to mentor under him, and launched multiple new men's groups and connection events!
- 3. Begin an outreach initiative for the elderly.
 - Two leaders, Diego and Sara, joined our team and have taken the first steps into reaching the elderly in the local homes.
- 4. Expand our leadership development initiatives.
 - We have continued our Wednesday morning "Team Developments" sessions, empowering and teaching our Volunteer Team leaders to lead and minister in practical ways.
- 5. Launch a new Spanish-language service to reach more locals.
 - We walked forward with our first step! At our Downtown Campus, our 1:30pm service is now fully in both English and Spanish from the stage (the other 3 continuing to be translated through headsets)

LOOKING AHEAD: VISION FOR 2026!

/n 2026, we are prayerfully pursuing new opportunities to expand the mission:

- 1. Developing and planting Freedom Ministry-- an inner-healing ministry focused on the spiritual, emotional, and relational healing that comes from the Holy Spirit.
- 2. Training at least 8 leaders to help oversee "Freedom Groups".
- 3. Begin the first iteration of a Prophetic Ministry Training that will lead to developing a Prophetic team.
- 4. To officially start the construction process in our new church building site.
